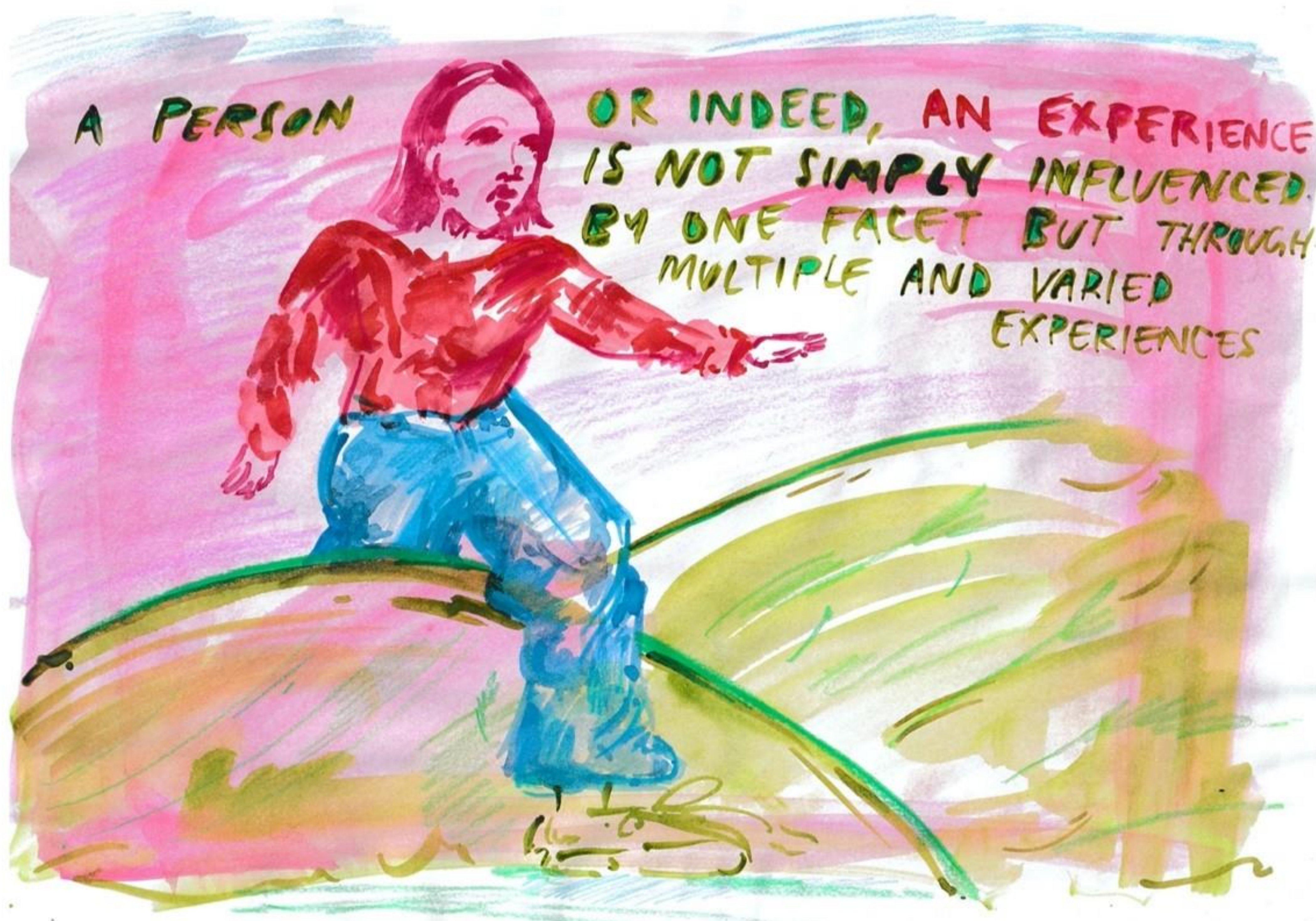


Artist's Statement
