MISMATCH BETWEEN TUTORS' AND MSC STUDENTS' UNDERSTANDING OF CRITERIA




TUTORS- EXAMINERS

- > Implicit understanding of criteria
- Difficult to articulate as complex and multidimensional-context dependent
- Unrealistic expectations
- Experience with Oxford UG students

STUDENTS

- Mis-conception of what essaywriting is and what is for- never written one
- Unfamiliarity with structure and conventions of scientific or discipline-specific discourse
- Not clear what critical thinking involves; originality?
- Difficult to interpret rubrics

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT TO DEVELOP STUDENTS' UNDERSTANDING OF ASSESSMENT CRITERIA?

01

Make expectations clear

- Standards to be met (PG vs UG) to achieve learning outcomes
- How work will be graded
- Al tools use

02

Promote inclusion

- Prior experience/background
- Cultural and neurodiversity

03

Promote self-regulated learning

- formative feedback
- expert and peer dialogue
